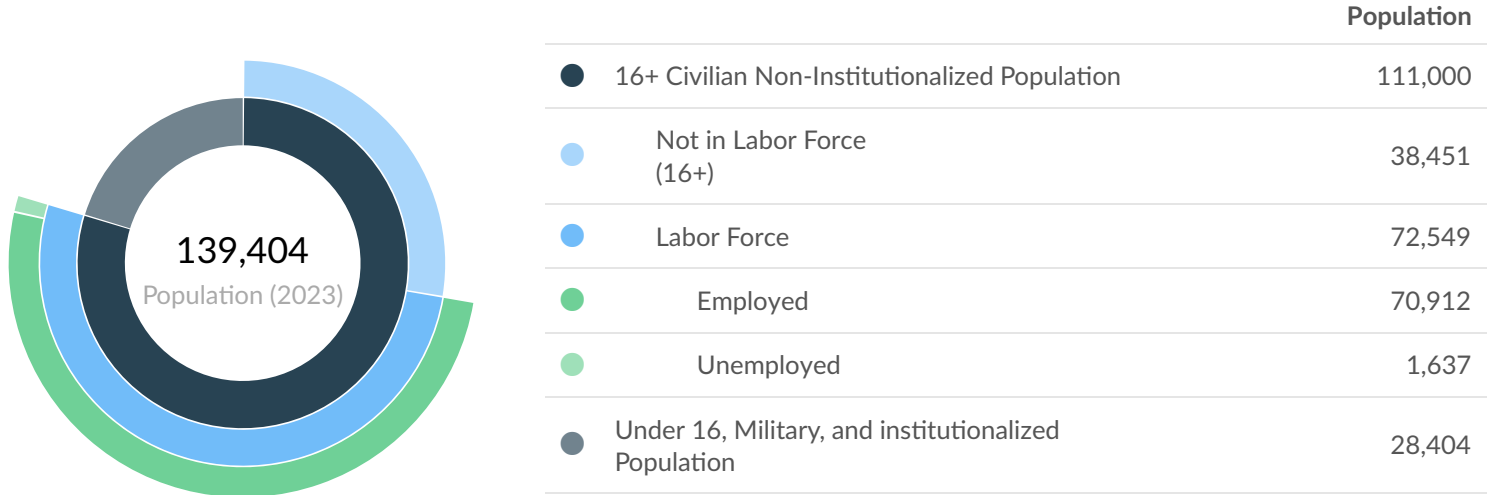
Median household income is **\$1.1K below** the national median household income of \$69.0K.

Takeaways

- As of 2022 the region's population **increased by 2.3%** since 2017, growing by 3,136. Population is expected to **increase by 2.5%** between 2022 and 2027, adding 3,436.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs **declined by 0.9%** in Marathon County, WI from 75,637 to **74,921**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 3.4% by 4.3%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 68.7% to 65.7% between 2017 and 2022**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **18.4% of Marathon County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (2.4% below the national average), and **14.0% hold an Associate's Degree** (5.2% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Dairy Product Manufacturing.

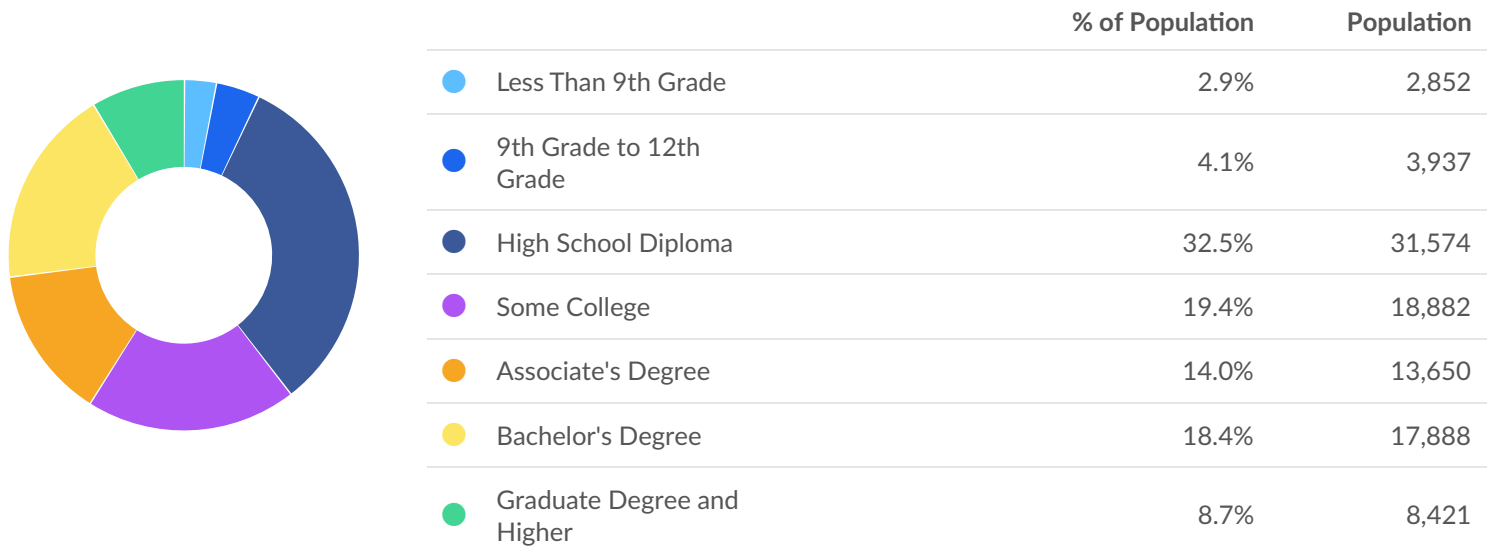

Jan 2023 Labor Force Breakdown



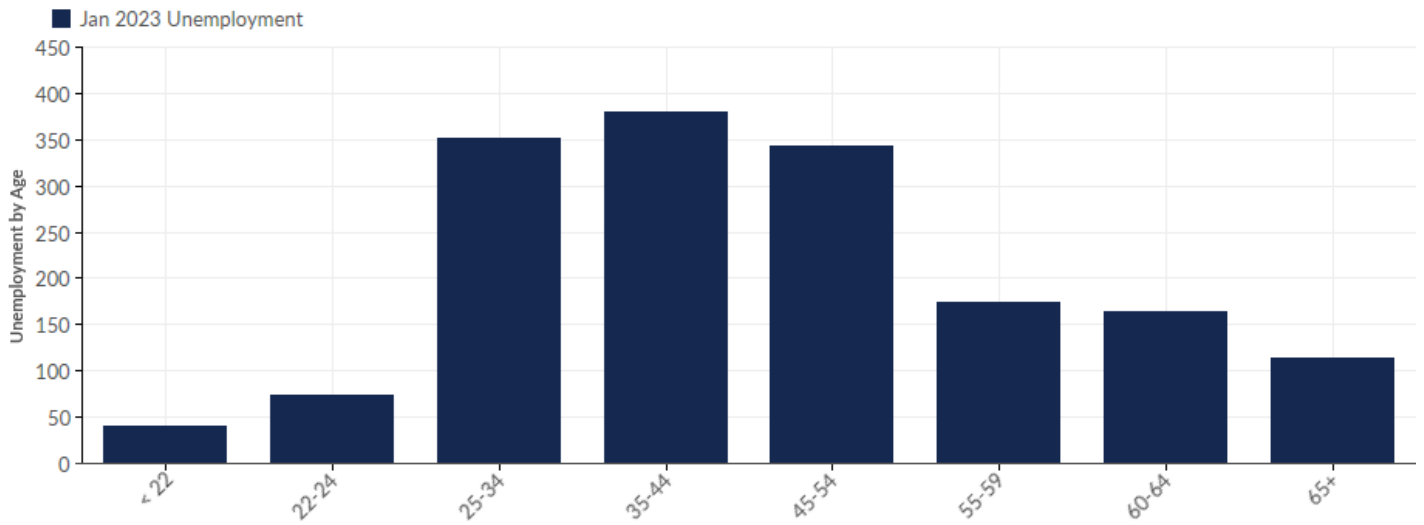
Educational Attainment

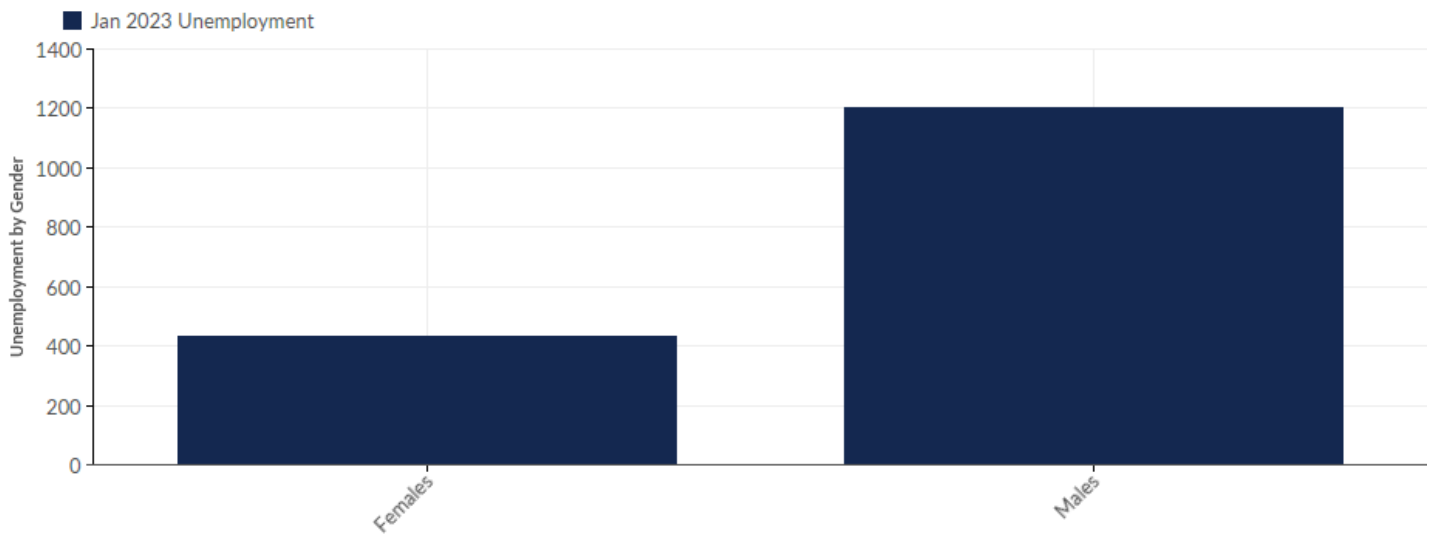

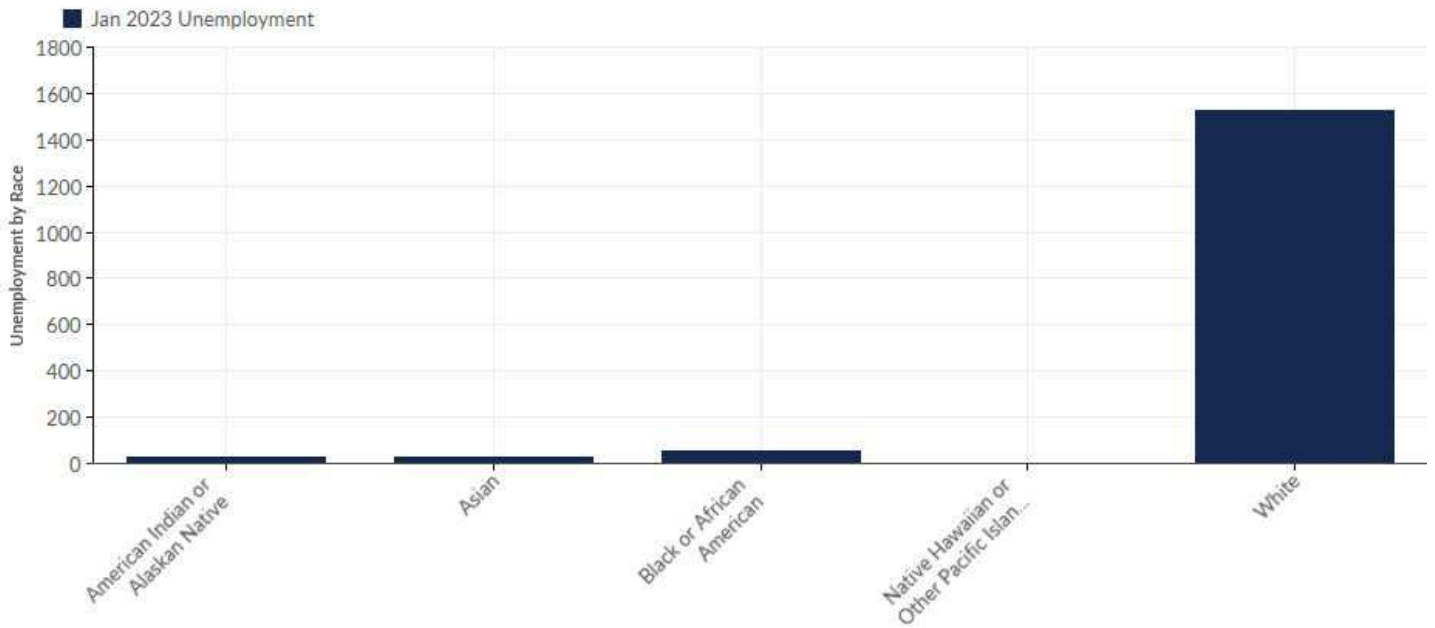

Unemployment by Gender



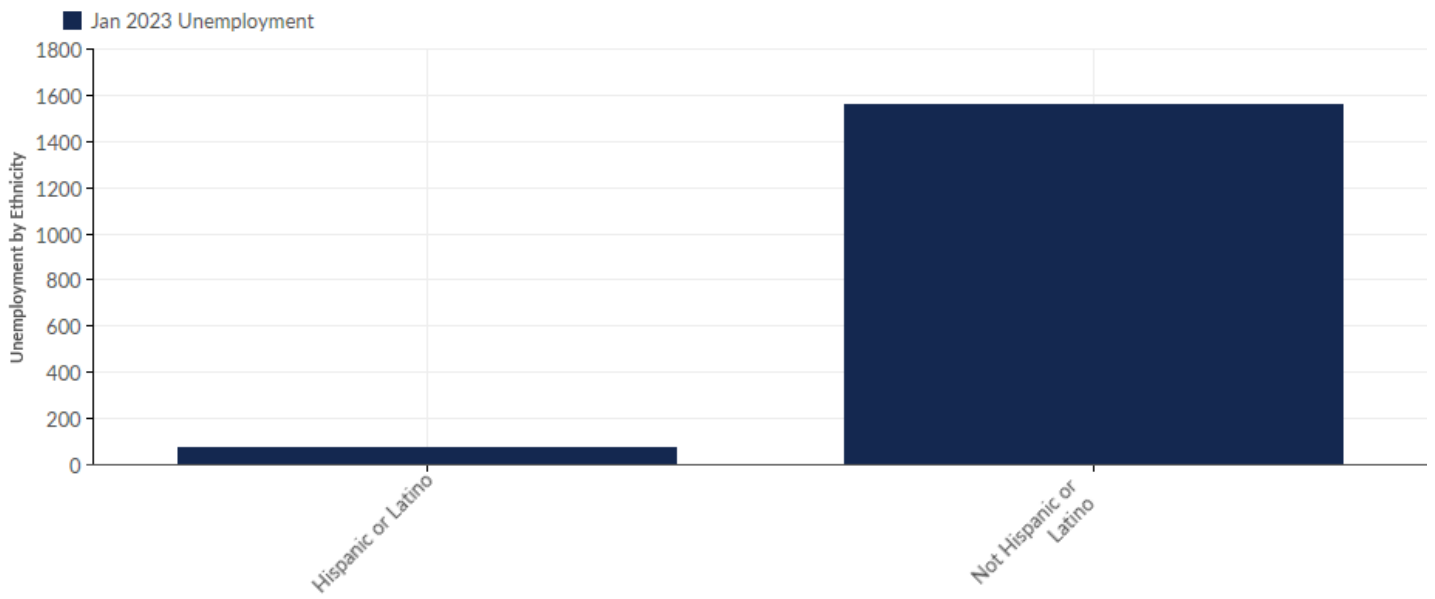

Unemployment by Ethnicity

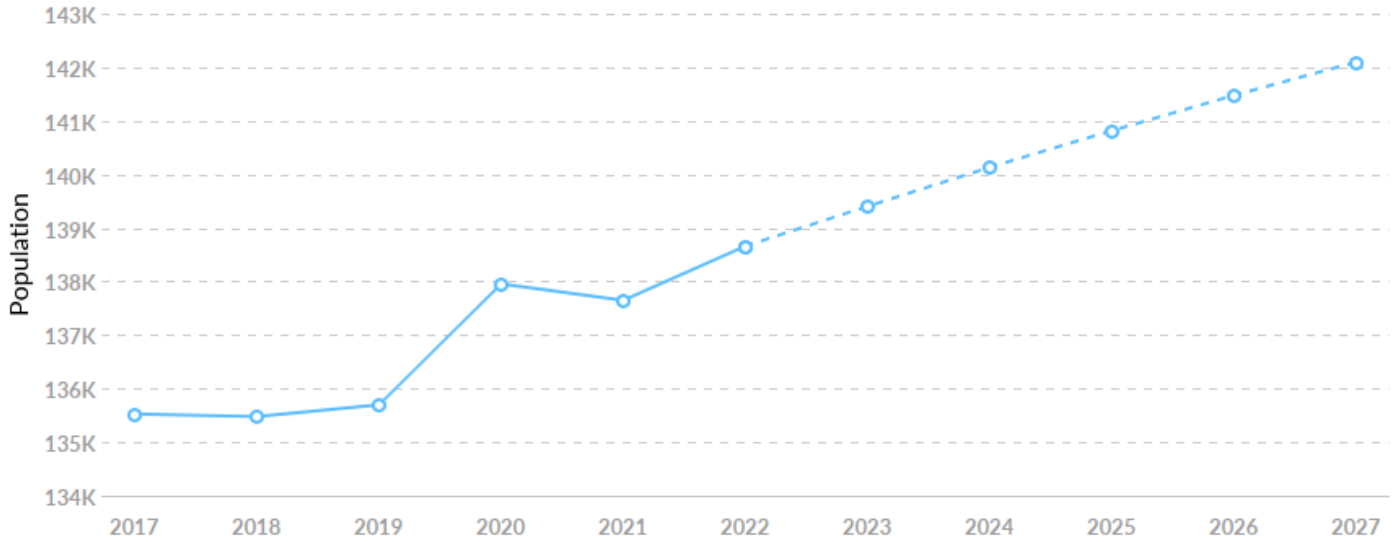

Population Trends

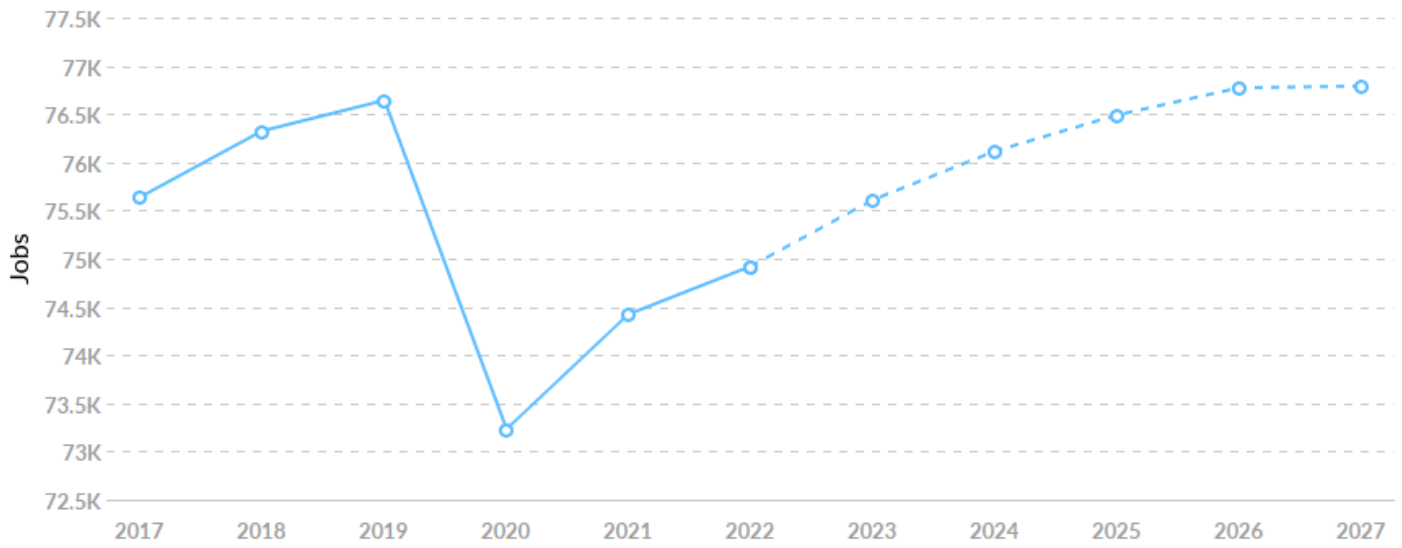

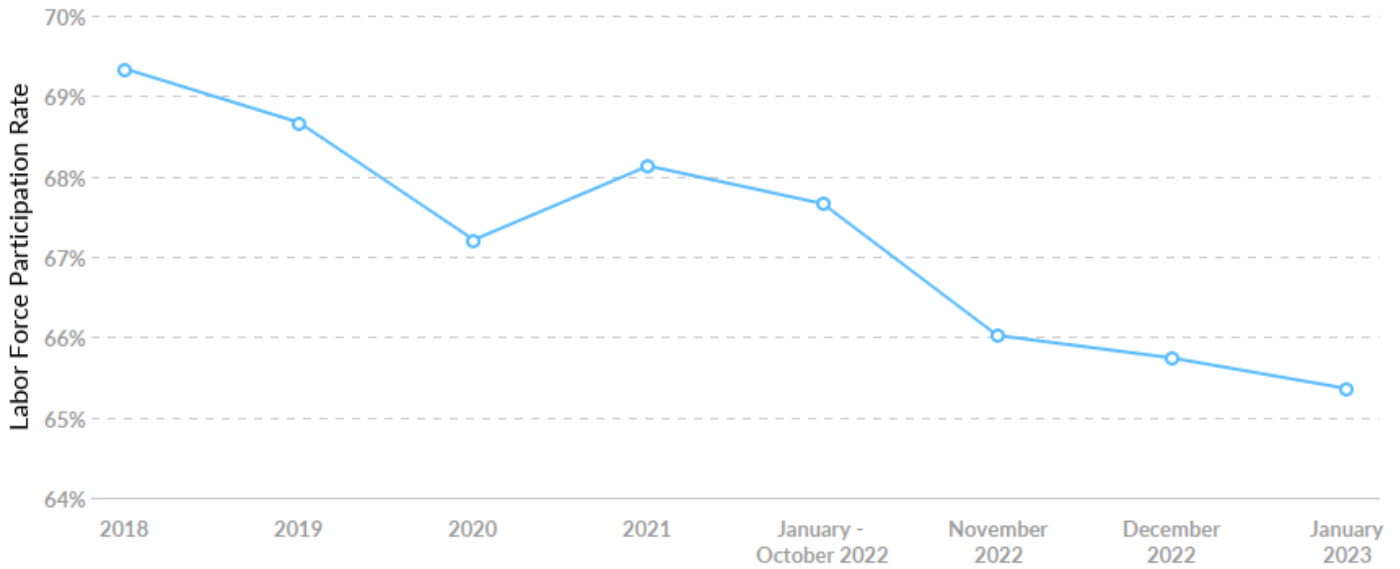
Job Trends

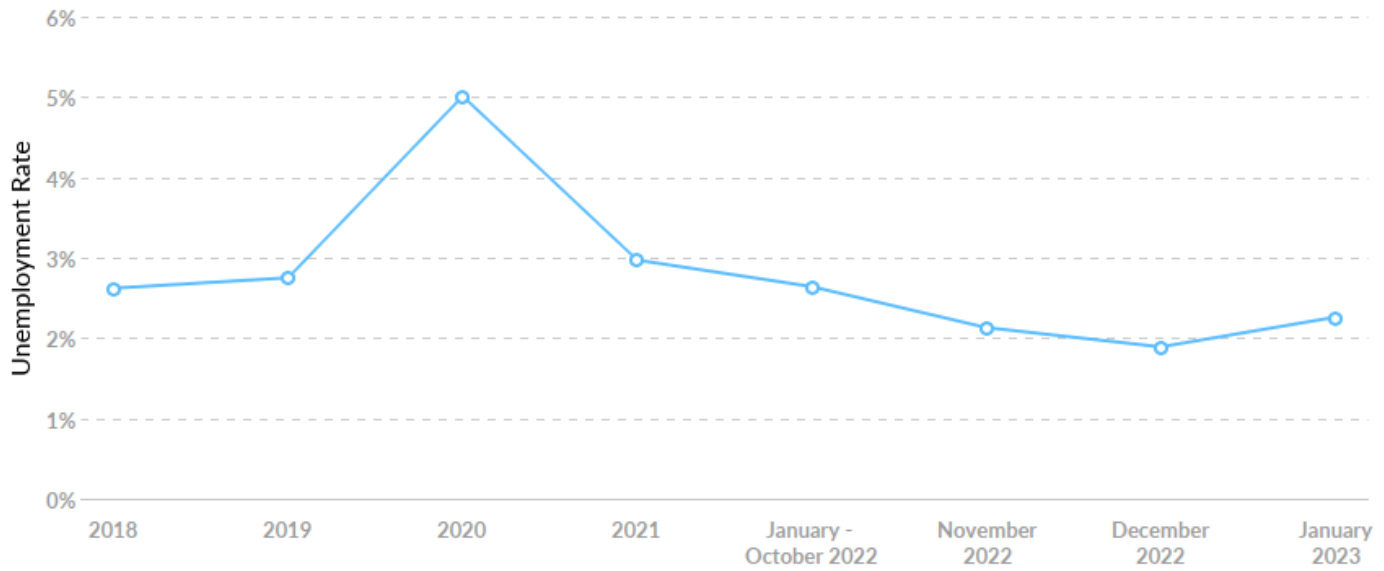

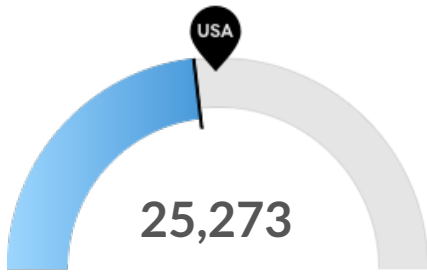
Unemployment Rate Trends

Marathon County, WI had a January 2023 unemployment rate of 2.26%, **decreasing from 2.62%** 5 years before.



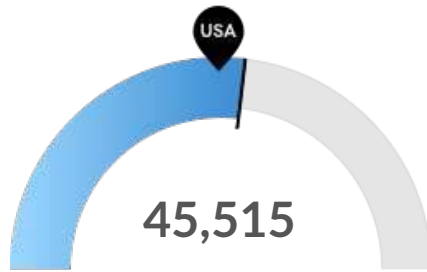

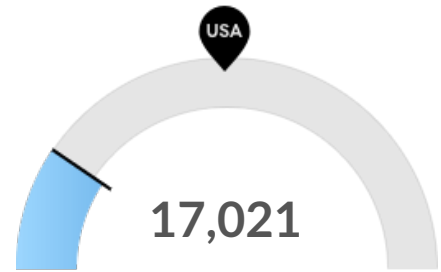
Millennials

Marathon County, WI has 25,273 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 28,117.



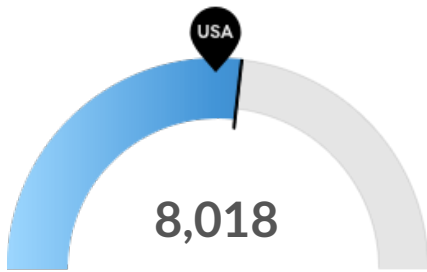
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Marathon County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 40,914 people 55 or older, while there are 45,515 here.



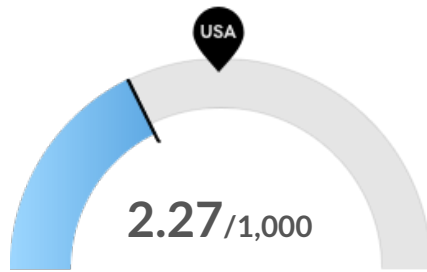
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Marathon County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 56,014 racially diverse people, while there are 17,021 here.



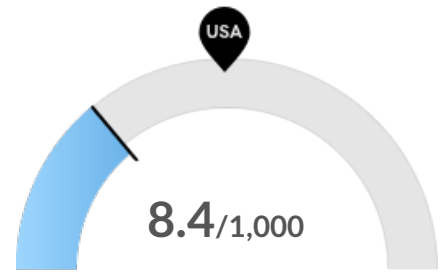
Veterans

Marathon County, WI has 2.27 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.59 per 1,000 people.

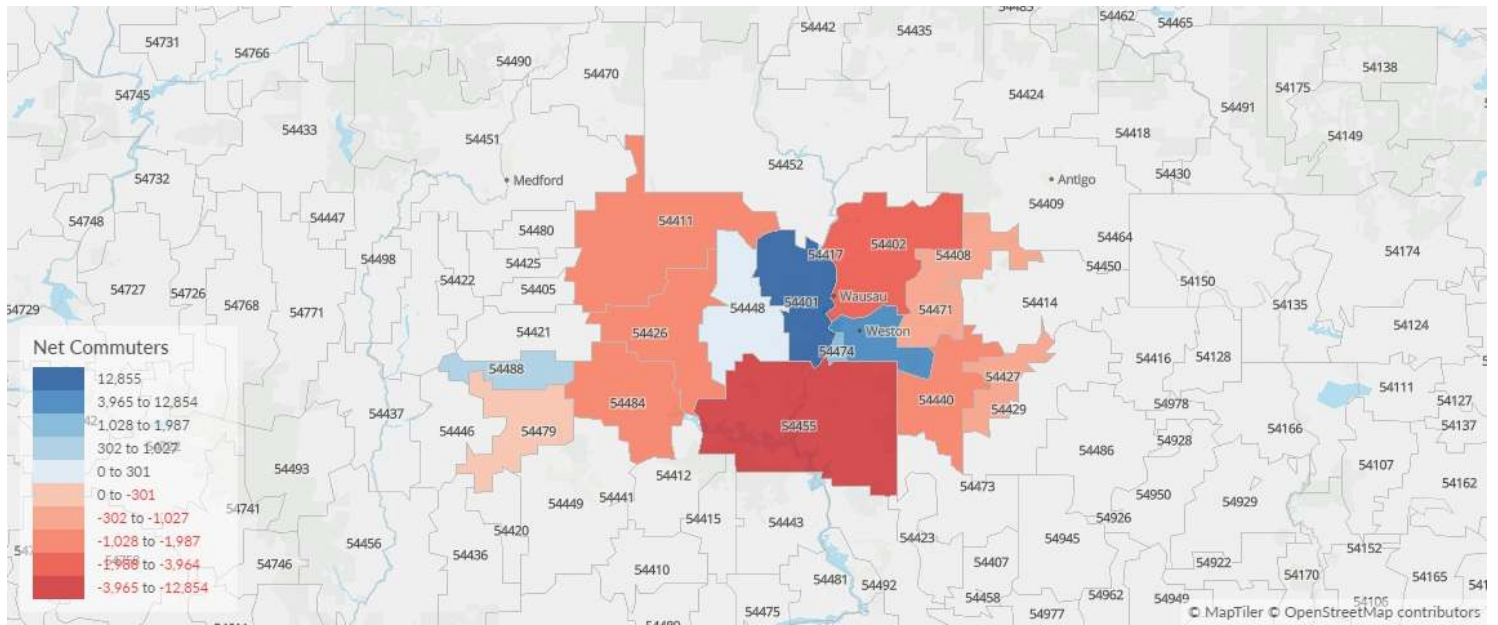


Property Crime

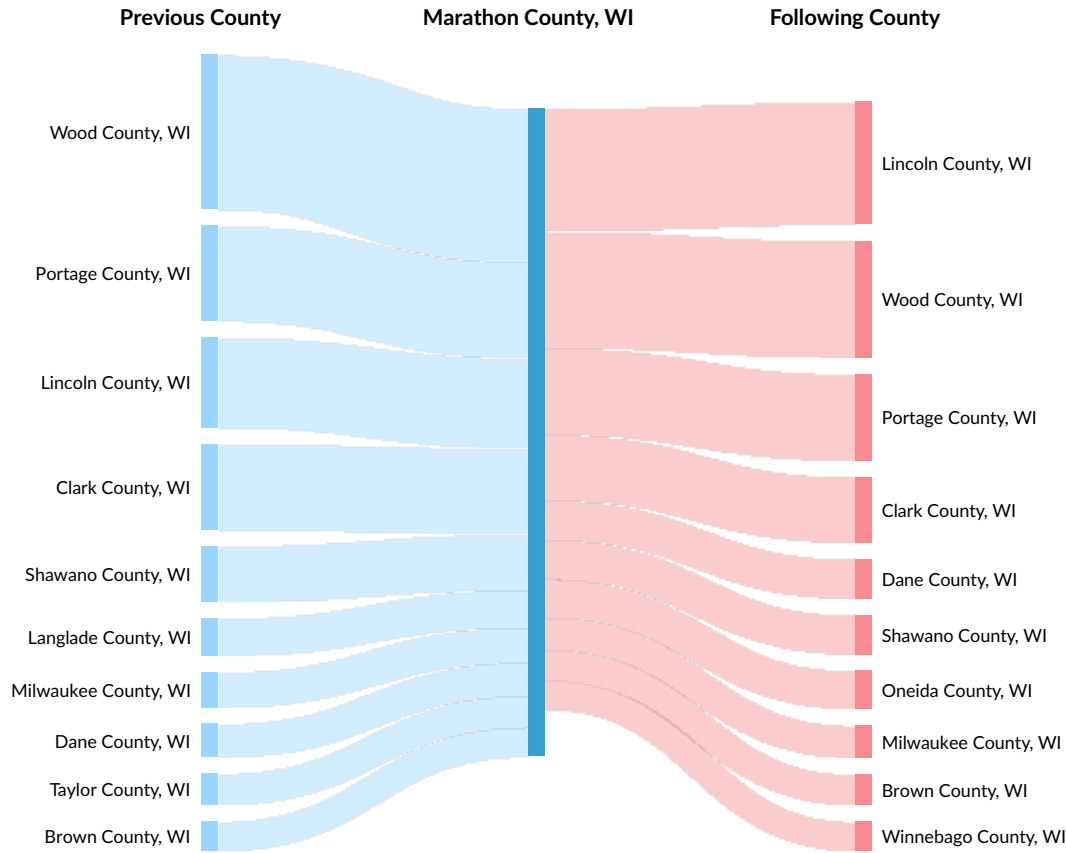

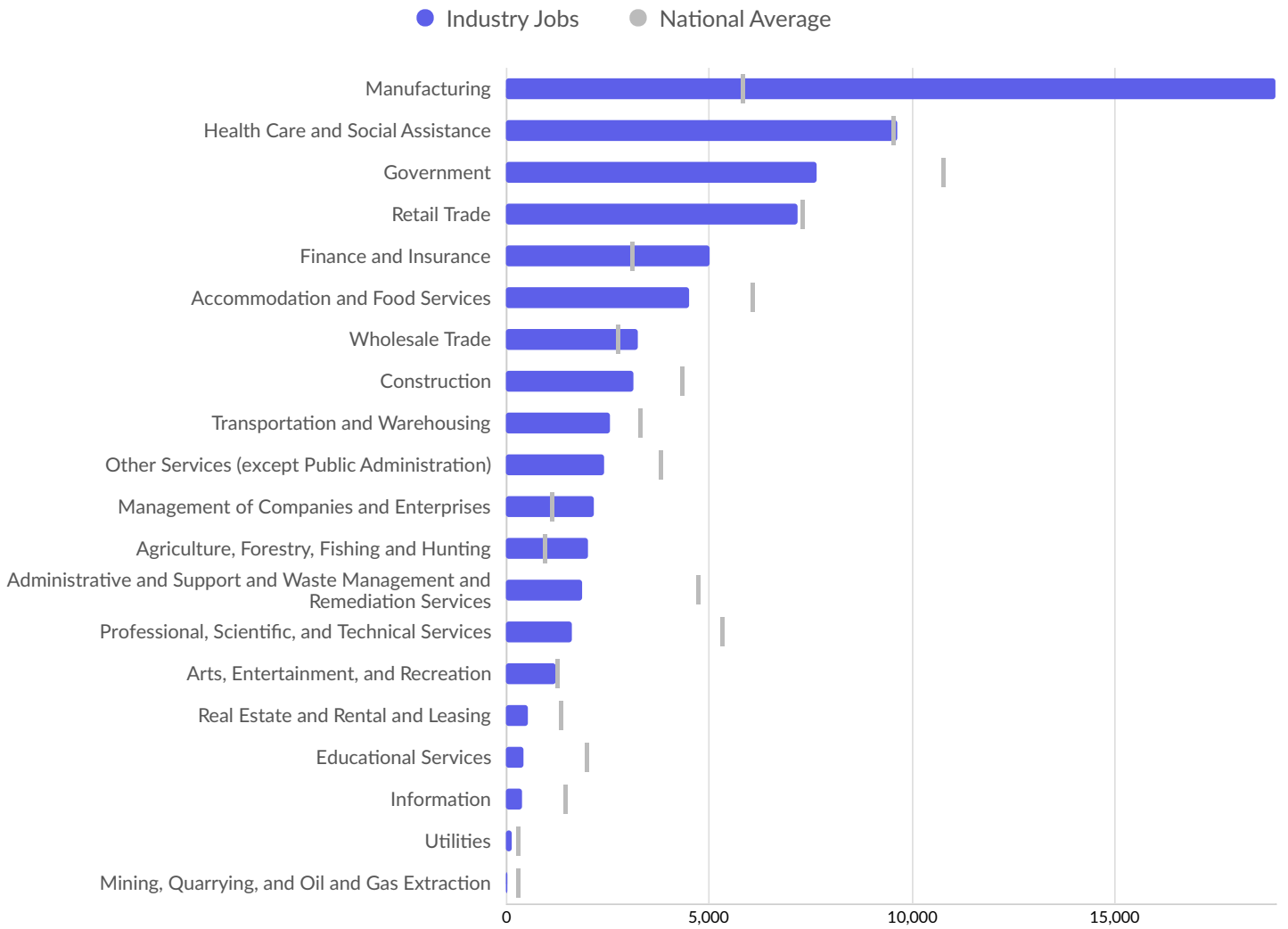

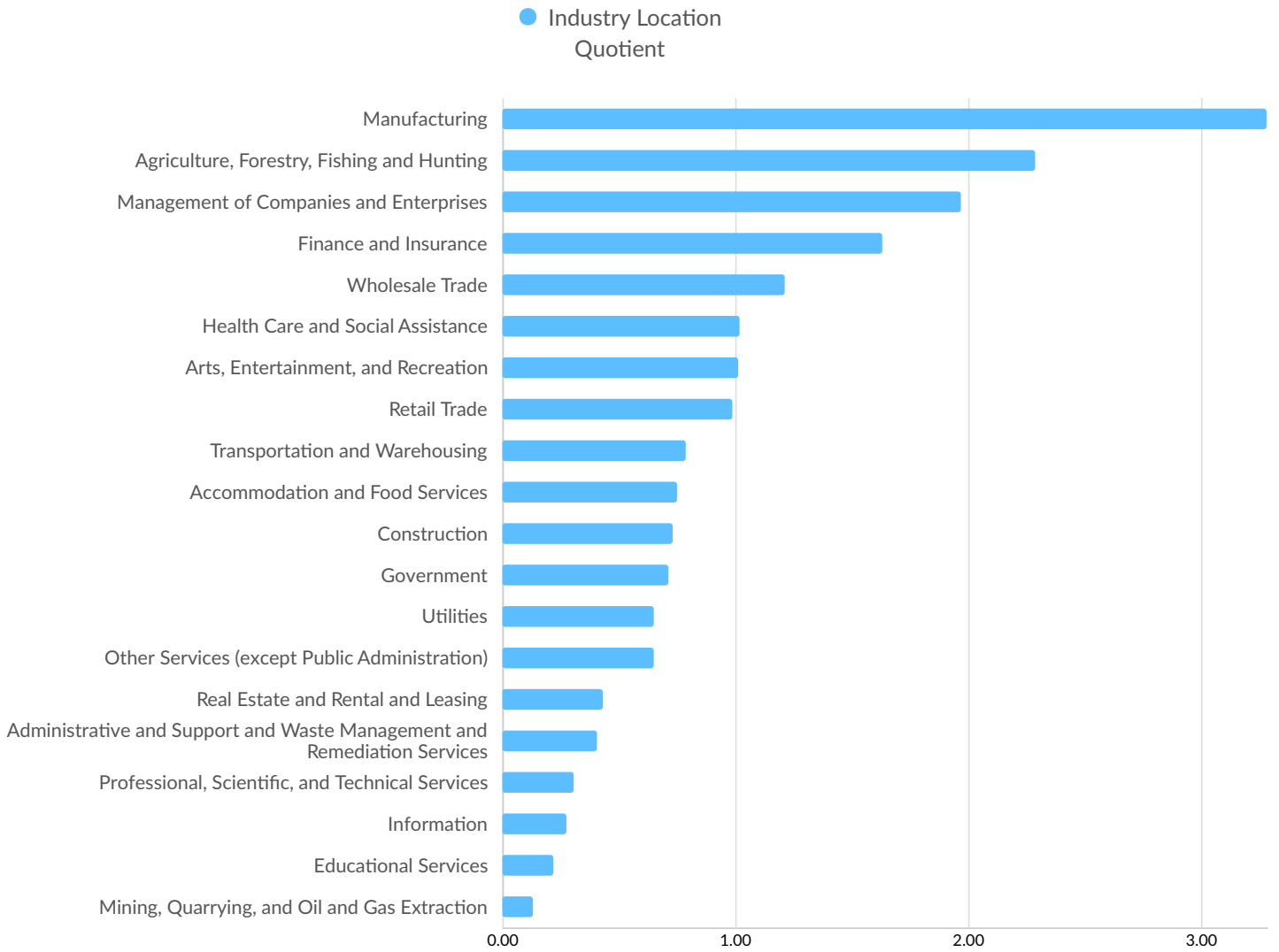

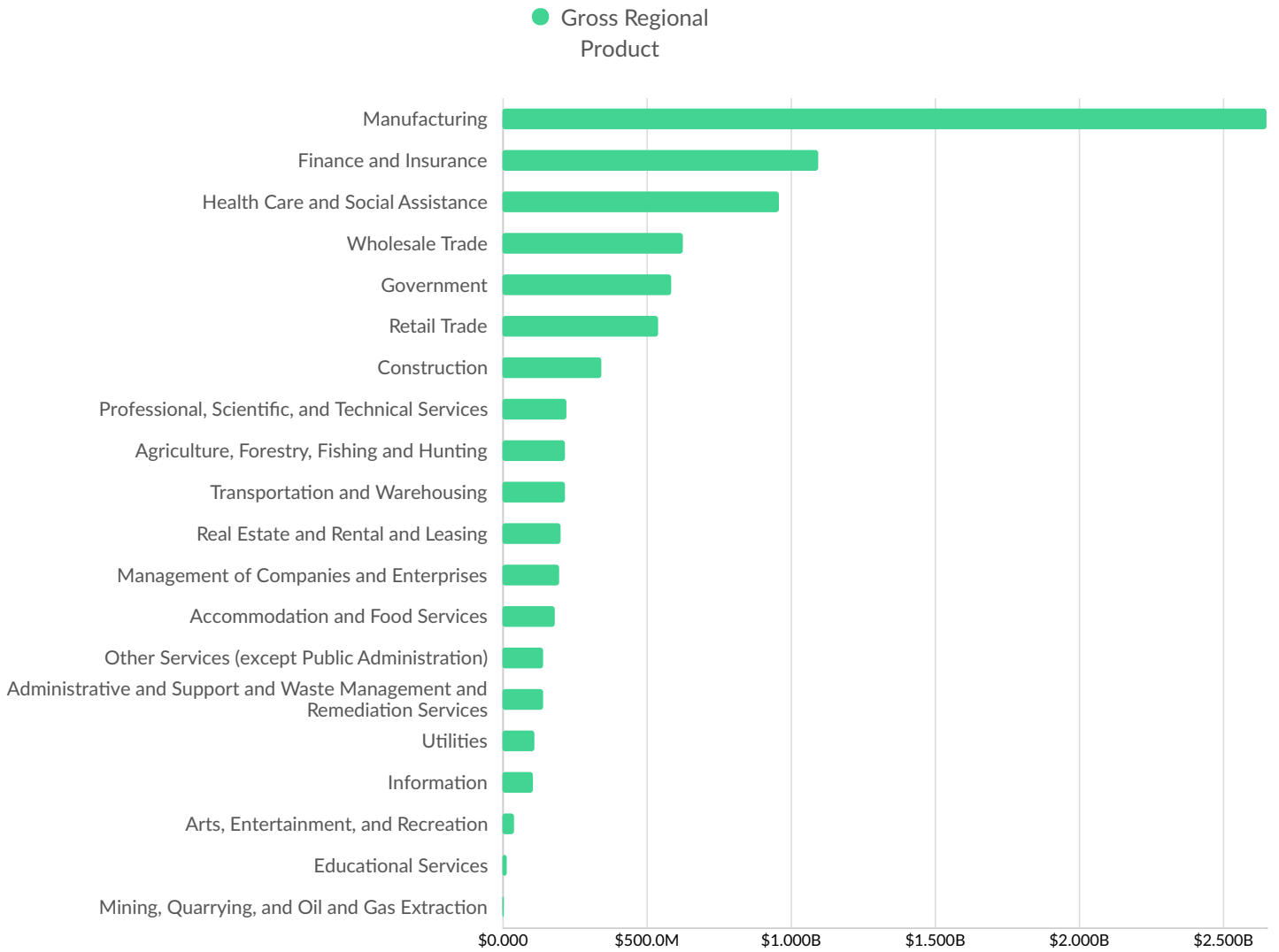
Top Growing Industries



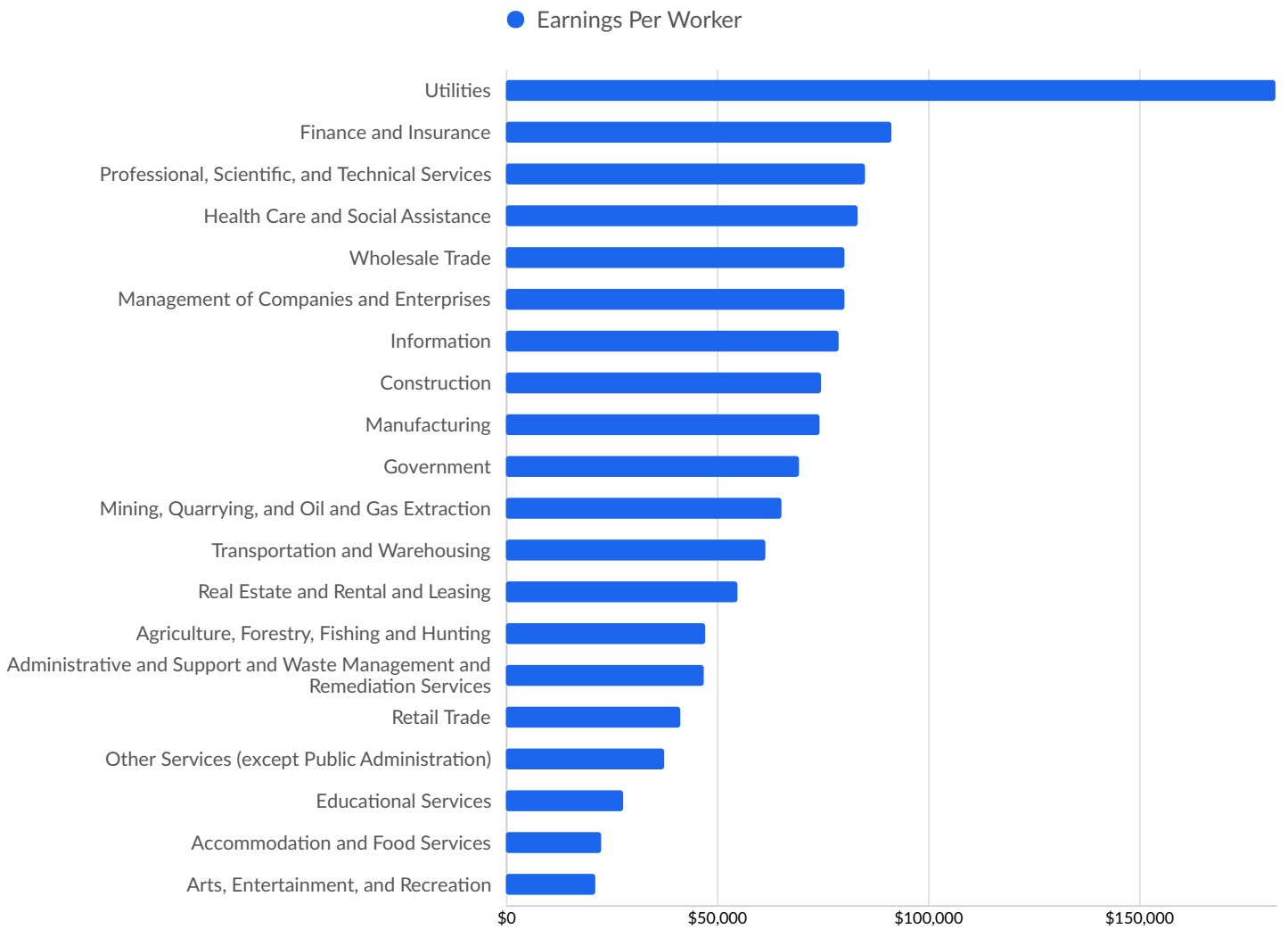
Top Industry Location Quotient

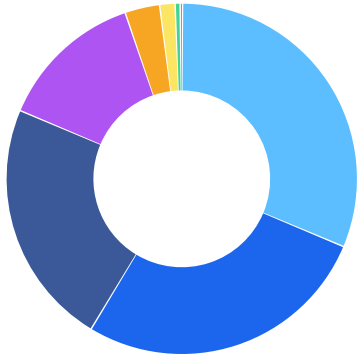

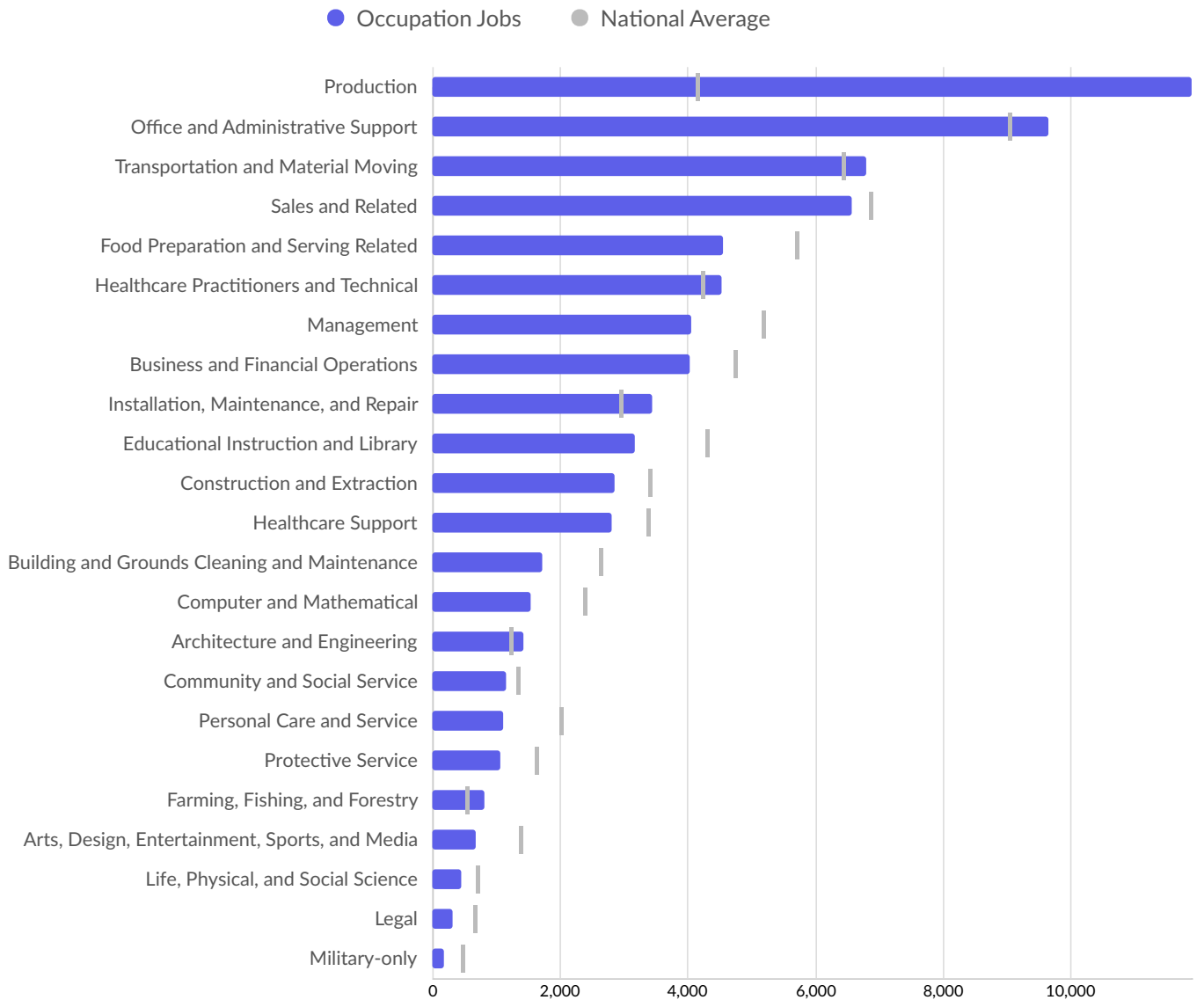

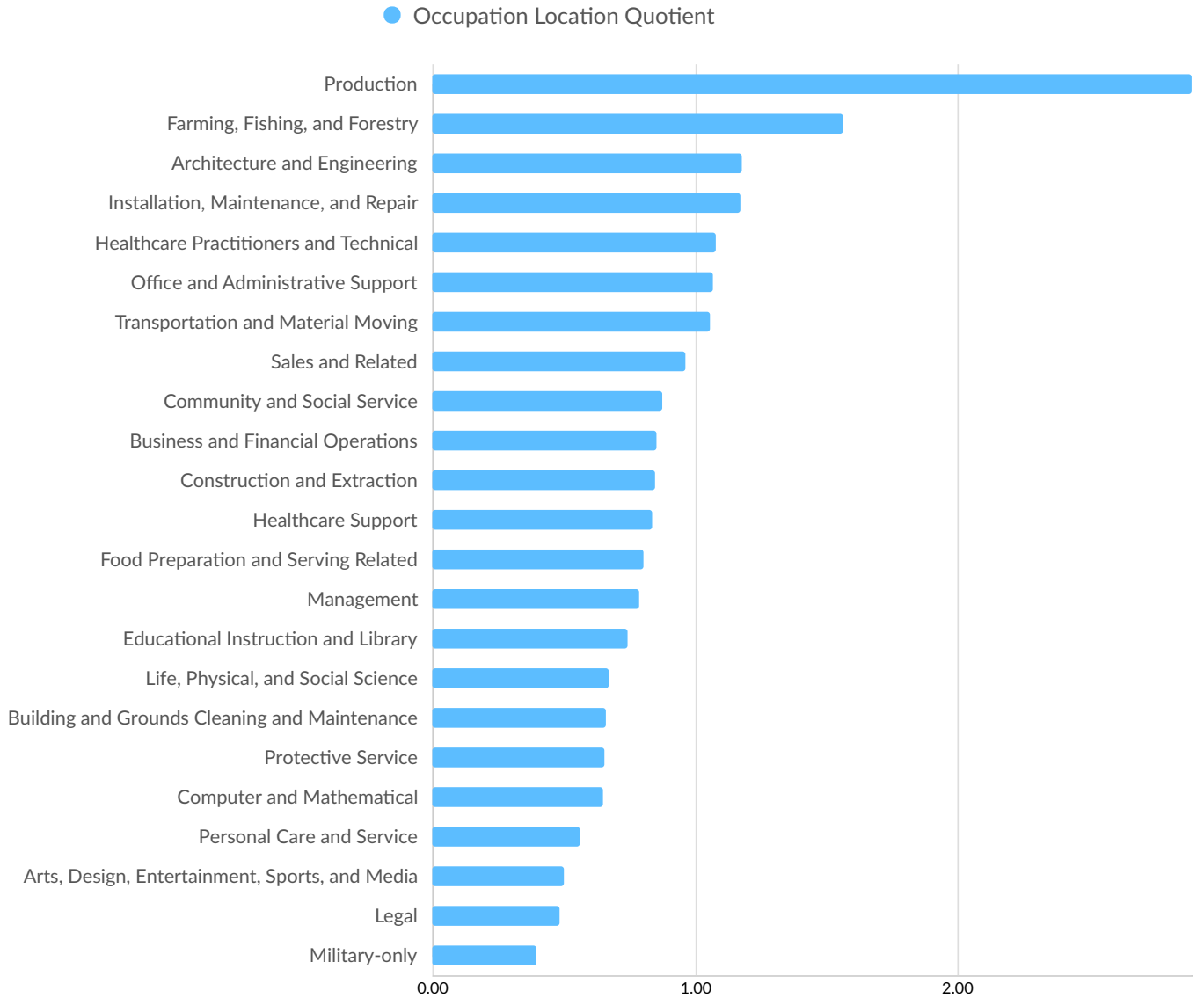

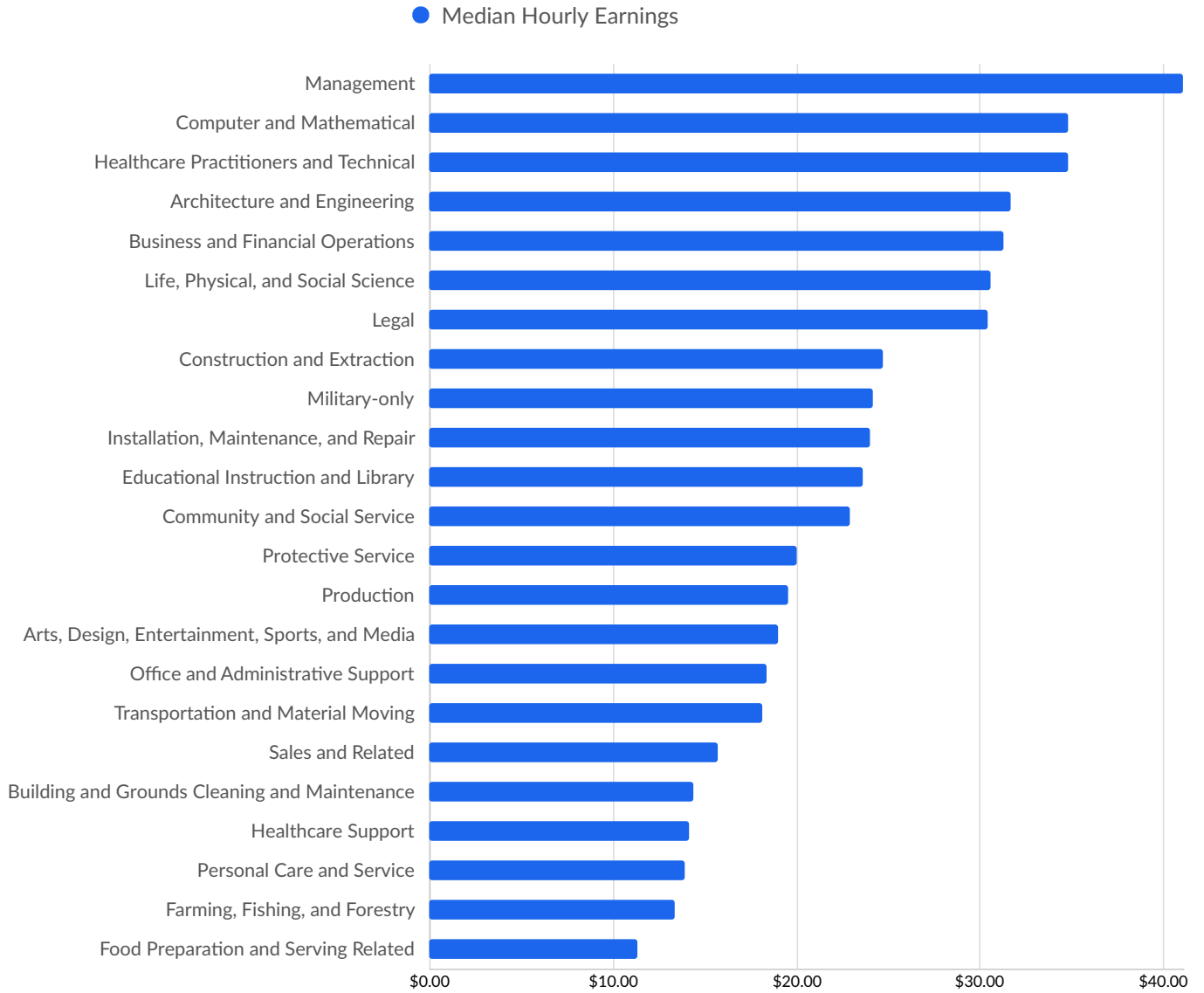
Top Growing Occupations



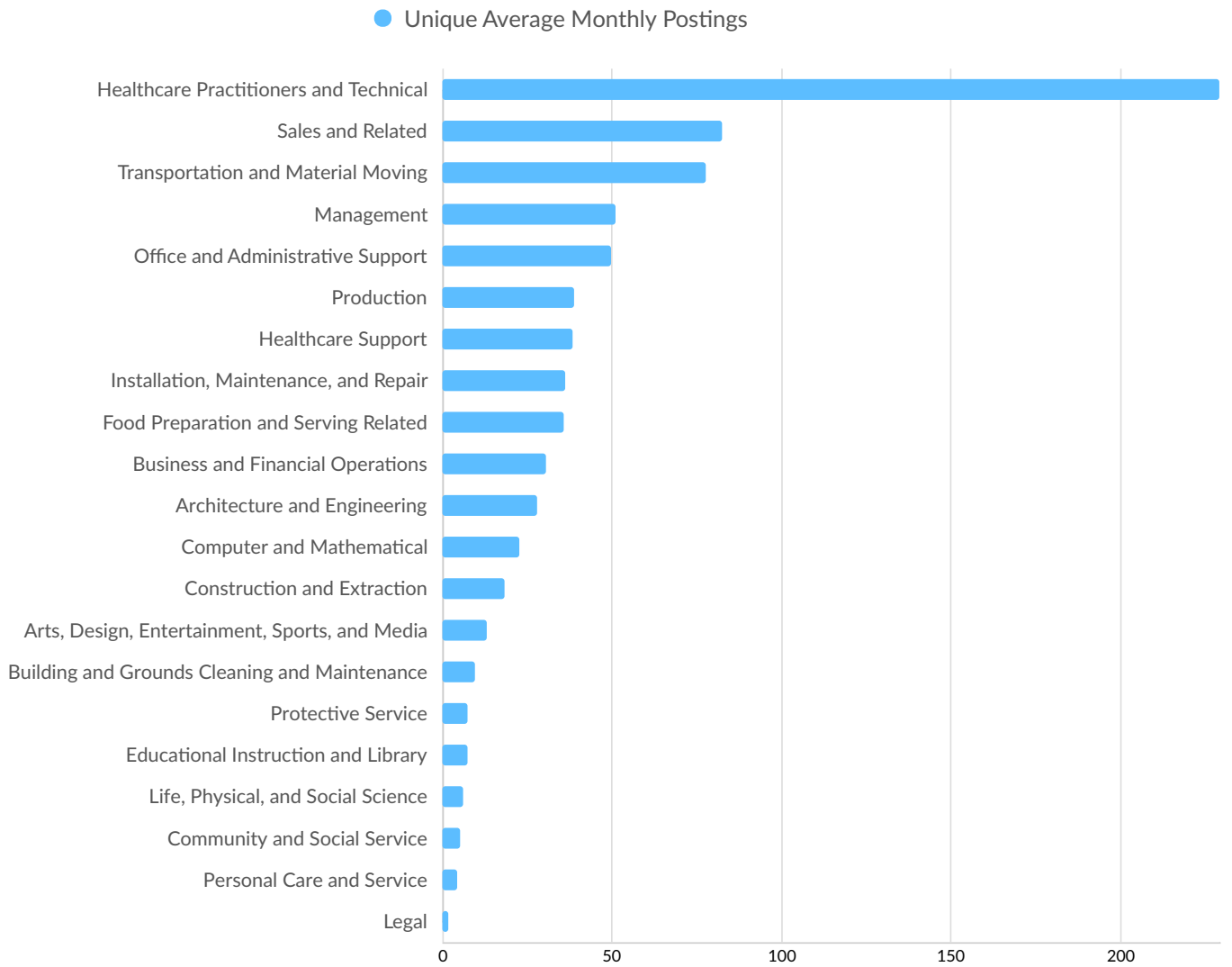
Top Occupation Location Quotient



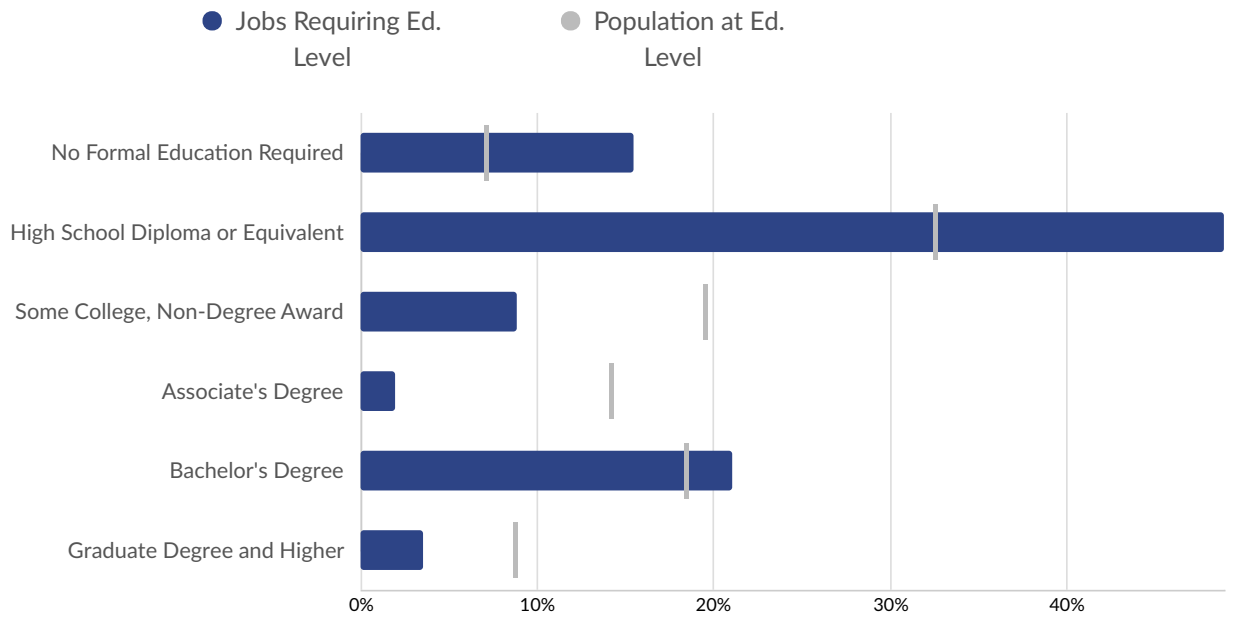
Top Occupation Earnings
