- From 2017 to 2022, jobs declined by 0.9% in Marathon County, WI from 75,637 to 74,921. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.4% by 4.3%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 68.7% to 65.7% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **18.4% of Marathon County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (2.4% below the national average), and **14.0% hold an Associate's Degree** (5.2% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Dairy Product Manufacturing.




#### Jan 2023 Labor Force Breakdown




















#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in Marathon County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 40,914 people 55 or older, while there are 45,515 here.




#### **Violent Crime**


