
Takeaways

- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 2.7% since 2017, growing by 4,389. Population is expected to increase by 3.2% between 2022 and 2027, adding 5,357.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs declined by 1.5% in Wausau-Weston, WI from 87,425 to 86,105. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.4% by 4.9%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 68.5% to 64.3% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **17.5% of Wausau-Weston, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.4% below the national average), and **13.7% hold an Associate's Degree** (4.9% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Dairy Product Manufacturing.






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Wausau-Weston, WI had a March 2023 unemployment rate of 2.21%, decreasing from 2.71% 5 years before.



Millennials


Wausau-Weston, WI has 29,716 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 33,947.






Veterans

Wausau-Weston, WI has 9,729 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 8,728.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Wausau-Weston, WI. The national average for an area this size is 49,397 people 55 or older, while there are 57,208 here.




Violent Crime








Top Growing Industries







Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP




Top Growing Occupations





Top Occupation Employment Concentration




Top Occupation Earnings







